Drag 15/17 or 18, stamped FELI[CIS] ; probably die 35a, Felix i of La Graufesenque and Le Rozier. *c* AD 55-85 (KW69 [10] (105)) [205467](#)

Ritt 8, stamped OFLVCCEI ; die 1e, Luceius i of La Graufesenque. *c* AD 30-65 (KW68 [8A] (43) (4/28) <242>; archive illustration no 320) [205468](#)

Drag 33, stamped MARTIM ; die 1b, Martius iv of Lezoux. *c* AD 155-190 (KW68 Ω [3] IV (4/150) <241>; archive illustration no 216) [205469](#)

Drag 18/31, stamped MERCA[I'] ; die 2c, Mercator ii of Lezoux. *c* AD 130-155 (KW68 [12] (5) and (7) <377> sf 39; archive illustration no 92) [205470](#)

Drag 18, stamped PATRICI ; die 13h, Patricius i of La Graufesenque. The stamp has been impressed off-centre. *c* AD 65-90 ([9] Pit 2) [205471](#)

Drag 33, stamped PRIMANI ; probably die 6m, Primanus iii of Lezoux. *c* AD 160-200 (KW72 (4/206) <244>; archive illustration no 321) [205472](#)

Drag 15/17, stamped OFPRIMI with swallowtail terminals; die 12g, Primus iii of La Graufesenque and Le Rozier. *c* AD 40-80 (KW77 [16] (9) <376> sf 375; archive illustration no 35) [205473](#)

Drag 33, stamped TITTIVS ; die 4a, Tittius of Lezoux. *c* AD 130-160. Burnt (KW77 [16] (11) <374> sf 372; archive illustration no 273) [205474](#)

Drag 18, stamped [C·VAL·A.]BAV ; die 3a, C. Valerius Albanus? of La Graufesenque. *c* AD 75-100. Slightly burnt (KW77 [16] (9)) [205475](#)

Drag 33, stamped]\YI\..SAIIL with a horizontal line through the final four letters; probably anepigraphic. Central or East Gaul, Antonine - early 3rd century (KW68 A4 (9) (4/15) <246>; archive illustration no 322)

Drag 31 with illegible fragment of stamp; Central Gaul, Antonine (KW67 [2] (7)) [Not seen in 2018]

Drag 31 or 31R, stamped]...I ; unidentifiable. Central Gaul, mid- to late Antonine (KW68 [2] B3)

Drag 33, stamped]F ; unidentifiable. Central Gaul, Hadrianic-Antonine (KW68 [9] (5))

Dish (Lud Tg, Walters 79 etc), possibly stamped PAT[; the first letter is very unclear and the stamp has not been identified. Rheinzabern, later 2nd to mid-3rd (KW68 [9] (12))

Drag 31, stamped]I[; unidentifiable. Central Gaul, Antonine (KW68 [10] (16))

Drag 33, stamped but so abraded and pitted that no letters are discernible. Central Gaul, Antonine. Graffito, probably reading CVRI, on exterior wall (Joining sherds from KW68 [10A] (9), [9]/[10] and [10] 1b)

Drag 31/Lud Sa, probably stamped]SI; unidentifiable. East Gaul, later 2nd to mid-3rd (KW69 [10W] (5d))

Drag 18/31 or 31, stamped]ANAI ; not identified. Central Gaul, Hadrianic-Antonine (KW69 [12E] (3))

Drag 18/31 or 31, stamped SA([or]VS ; not identified. Central Gaul, Hadrianic-Antonine (Unnumbered)
